The Waters' products at issue include, without limitation, "Atlantis Premier," "ACQUITY Premier," "XBridge Premier," "XSelect Premier," "CORTECS Premier," and "MaxPeak Premier SEC" chromatography columns, and "ACQUITY Premier" and "Arc Premier" chromatography systems.
